MR WATT ASKED THE MINISTER FOR MAIN ROADS, FISHERIES AND MARINE INFRASTRUCTURE (MR WALLACE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise on the next steps to deliver the commitment made at the Albany Creek Community Cabinet to install noise barriers on Old Northern Road, Albany Creek?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Everton for the question.

The department has completed an initial assessment along Old Northern Road and will now undertake noise measuring at residences that are likely to have high noise levels. The measuring takes four days at each residence and is programmed for May 2011.

The data from the noise measuring will be used to create a noise model that is expected to be completed by September 2011.

The noise model will then be used to design the additional noise barriers and construction will be carried out in the first half of 2012.

I look forward to further updating the Member for Everton as this important project progresses.
