MRS ATTWOOD asked the Minister for Transport and Multicultural Affairs
(MS PALASCZUK) —

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the House in relation to total funding spent on the recent refurbishment of Oxley Station and the complete upgrade of Darra Station in my electorate of Mt Ommaney?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Mount Ommaney for the question.

Since 2008, \$13.54 million has been spent on Oxley station to deliver:

- new car park - 80 car spaces on Ardoyne Road
- new concrete footbridge
- new side platform - Platform 3 with disability access, new canopy, signage, closed-circuit television cameras and real time train information
- refurbishment of the bus interchange area
- new shelters
- refurbishment of the subway
- new artwork.

Further work to the station building and resurfacing platforms, is yet to be carried out.

Since February 2011, \$35.23 million has been spent on Darra station to deliver:

- subway refurbishment
- new side of Platform 1 adjacent to shops
- upgrade to Platforms 2, 3 and 4
- lift access to Platforms 2, 3 and 4
- at-grade and ramp access to Platform 1
- new canopies, closed-circuit television camera, seating, lighting, signage, real time train information
- new car park - 44 car spaces adjacent to the footbridge on Manburgh Terrace
- new car park -16 car spaces, including 6 disability car parks adjacent to lifts on Manburgh Terrace
- new footbridge
- new station building on Platform 4.

The upgrade works for Darra station were completed in February 2011.
