QUESTION:

With the Gold Coast renal dialysis facility now at full capacity, what measures are in place to increase the renal dialysis service provided at Redland Hospital, which has documented evidence of six renal chairs not being used on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday afternoons due to a lack of funding (and business cases and submissions have been submitted to fund these shifts for the past two years but have been unsuccessful) and will the Minister commit the funding to open six extra chairs in Redlands to address the need?
