MR CRANDON asked the Minister for Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services (MS DAVIS)—

QUESTION

With reference to the Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services—

Will the Minister advise (a) the number, type and value of all procurement contracts with an annual expenditure over \$50,000 that have been rolled over in the past three years without review (in table format based on financial year) and (b) how many procurement contracts with an annual expenditure over \$50,000 are coming up for review in 2012-13?

ANSWER

- (a) Nil – the Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services does not roll over (extend) contracts without first undertaking a contract performance review.
- (b) Nine non-Information Communication and Technology (ICT) and 29 ICT contracts and supply arrangements will be reviewed in 2012–13 prior to any extension options being exercised or contracts renewed. Renewal of all contracts will be subject to government priorities at that time.
