Question on Notice No. 269 Asked on 18 April 2013

MS PALASZCZUK asked the Minister for Health (MR SPRINGBORG)-

QUESTION:

With reference to the Newman Government's decision to cut 4,140 full-time equivalent positions in Queensland Health—

Will the Minister outline, for the following Health and Hospital Services – Metro North, Metro South, Central Queensland, Mackay, and Cairns and Hinterland (listed separately, in a format similar to Minister Emerson's response to Question on Notice No. 92) (a) a list of all positions filled, vacant or planned to be made redundant in 2012-13, (b) the functions of these positions, (c) the location of each position and (d) the salary level of each position?

ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Inala for her question.

I am advised that the total temporary and permanent staff separations and initial staff appointments across all Queensland Health facilities from 1 July 2012 to 28 April 2013 are 14,773 (headcount), 12,455 (FTE).

Due to the significant number of staff movements, i.e. separations and appointments across facilities as indicated above, it is not practical or reasonable to expect me to provide the specific detailed information for each of the Hospital and Health Services as requested by the Honourable Member.
