MR HOLSWICH asked the Minister for Transport and Main Roads (MR EMERSON)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise whether any modelling has been done on extra trains travelling on the Caboolture line once the Moreton Bay Rail Link opens and what impact this will have on level crossings such as the Todds Road crossing at Lawnton and the South Pine Road crossing at Strathpine

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Pine Rivers for the question.

Any additional frequency of rail services on the Caboolture line associated with Moreton Bay Rail Link will be more focussed on off-peak periods when vehicle traffic is generally less. As a result, a significant increase in congestion at level crossings such as Todds Road and South Pine Road is not anticipated.
