MR WELLINGTON asked the Minister for Police and Community Safety (MR DEMPSEY) -

QUESTION:

With reference to my recent correspondence in relation to the ambulance service decision involving ambulances being driven on the Obi Obi Road on the Sunshine Coast- Will the Minister, or one of his senior staff drive, this road in an ambulance with me so as to better understand the reason for the decision involving the driving of ambulances on this road?

ANSWER:

I travelled on the Obi Obi Road with the Member on 23 June 2013 as he requested.

I am advised the Department of Transport and Main Roads has recently carried out road repairs which have improved the road, and further works are to be undertaken.

Queensland Ambulance Service vehicles continue to use the Obi Obi Road as required and crews are instructed to exercise care and discretion when doing so.
