Mrs Desley Scott MP asked the Minister for Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services (MS DAVIS)—

QUESTION

With reference to page 17 of the Minister's portfolio Service Delivery Statement, which lists grants and subsidies—Will the Minister provide a full list of community groups or organisations (a) to be funded in 2013-14, including the size and purpose of the grant/subsidy for each organisation and (b) that received grants and/or subsidies in 2012-13 and which will not receive a grant and/or subsidy in 2013-14?

ANSWER

The Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services delivers a broad range of frontline human services.

Non-government organisations deliver some of these programs for community, child and family and disability services to vulnerable Queenslanders.

Organisations may receive more funding throughout the year as individuals choose to move between service providers and when additional funding such as the Caring for our Community grants or Emergency Relief funding is approved.

Many organisations receive one-off or time limited grants in one financial year. In 2012–13, 268 organisations received time limited funding. Of these, 240 organisations received Caring for our Community grants in 2012–13 and it is unknown which organisations will receive funding under this initiative in 2013–14. Funding for 11 organisations that were funded in 2012–13 was discontinued.
