MR JUDGE asked the Premier (MR NEWMAN)—

Will the Premier detail all overseas travel by government members and specifically include the dates, destinations, duration, costs and purpose of all travel overseas by each government member?

ANSWER:

If approval is granted for any Member of the Queensland Legislative Assembly to travel overseas utilising public funds (including travel by Ministers, the Speaker or the Leader of the Opposition), then the member is required to table a report on their travel in the Parliament upon their return.

Furthermore, the cost of any overseas travel by Ministers and the Leader of the Opposition is reported to the Parliament on a bi-annual basis in the public reports of ministerial and opposition expenses, while the cost of any overseas daily travelling allowance claims made by members are reported to the Parliament in the annual report of daily travelling allowance claims.
