MR HOLSWICH asked the Minister for Transport and Main Roads (MR EMERSON) —

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the car parking capacities of Lawnton, Bray Park and Strathpine Railway Stations and advise whether there are any planned upgrades to parking facilities at these stations?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Pine Rivers for the question.

The Queensland Rail website reports that the parking capacities at the stations are as follows:

- Bray Park 152 car spaces
- Lawnton 159 car spaces
- Strathpine 398 car spaces

At Lawnton, Queensland Rail lease a site that is used as an informal overflow car park with an estimated additional capacity of 70 car spaces.

There are no planned upgrades to parking facilities at these three stations this financial year.
