MR BYRNE asked the Minister for Police and Community Safety (MR DEMPSEY)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister list the rewards, including sum offered and reason for reward, that have been approved to be offered to the public to assist with Queensland Police investigations for the last five financial years?

ANSWER:

Four Government rewards have been offered to the public, over the past five financial years, to assist with police investigations.

The following table outlines those rewards.

Date Posted	Sum Offered	Reason
5 August 2010	\$200,000	For information leading to the apprehension and conviction of person or persons responsible for the crop poisonings at two Bowen properties between 20 and 25 June 2010.
7 October 2010	\$50,000	For information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for a fatal 'hit and run' road crash at Townsville on 15 January 2009.
15 February 2012	\$250,000	For information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the disappearance of Peter James Johnson, 35 years at Nebo on or about 16 April 2003.
10 September 2012	\$250,000	For information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Gerhard Bruno Wagner at Brisbane on or about 7 January 1999.
