

## **Question on Notice**

**Asked on Thursday, 12 September 2013**

Mrs Miller asked the Minister for Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services (MS DAVIS)—

### **QUESTION**

Will the Minister outline funding provided by the department for 2012-13 (actual) and 2013-14 (estimate) for all non-government organisations located and/or operating in the Logan City Council local government area (listed separately and broken down into Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services)?

### **ANSWER**

The Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services delivers a broad range of frontline human services in the Logan area.

Non-government organisations deliver some of these programs for community, child and family and disability services to vulnerable people in the community.

In Logan during 2012–13, 76 organisations received \$96.735 million in grant funding. This funding only represents organisations that are located within the Logan area. However, the department does fund a number of organisations, peaks and representative networks across the State that may also deliver services in the Logan area, but are located outside of it.

Funding breakdown for 2012–13:

- Child Safety received \$41.831 million in 2012–13
- Disability Services received \$42.407 million in 2012–13
- Communities received \$12.497 million in 2012–13

In relation to the second part of the members question – total funding figures for 2013–14 is not yet available given that organisations may receive additional funding throughout the year as individuals choose to move between service providers and when additional funding such as Caring for our Community grants or Emergency Relief funding is approved.
