MR HOLSWICH asked the Minister for Police and Community Safety (MR DEMPSEY)—

QUESTION:

What training has been provided to Queensland Police Service officers in preparation for the implementation of the government's new anti-hooning legislation?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Police Service's Education and Training Command and Road Policing Command have developed an online learning product called *Motor Vehicle Impoundment Legislation*. This product covers the new laws and the changes to the processes and impoundment periods for the relevant vehicle related offences.

The product was released on 19 September 2013 and is compulsory for all sworn police up to and including the level of Inspector. This training takes approximately four hours to complete and was required to be completed by relevant officers by 1 November 2013.
