DR DOUGLAS asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning (MR SEENEY) –

QUESTION:

With reference to state-owned land at 7 Holyrood Road, Maudsland, known as Maudsland Community Waste and Recycling (property number: 183520 RPD: Lot 208 WD5236) –

Will the Deputy Premier outline future plans for the land, and advise if it will be sold?

ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Gaven for his question.

The state-owned land at 7 Holyrood Road, Maudsland, or Coomera Refuse Transfer Station (Lot 208 on Plan WD5236) is a Local Government Reserve held in trust by Gold Coast City Council for refuse transfer purposes.

As trustees of the property, Gold Coast City Council are in effect the “owners and managers” of the property. The Department of Natural Resources and Mines advises that it is not aware of any intention or desire on the part of Council to withdraw from the reserve or amend its current use.
