MR WELLINGTON asked the Minister for Health (MR SPRINGBORG)-

QUESTION:

With reference to the Nambour Hospital—

How many beds are empty at the moment and how many casual staff are on the waiting list seeking full time employment?

ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Nicklin for his question.

The Nambour General Hospital is a busy facility and I am advised that its available bed stock is utilised dependent on patient demand.

I am further advised that as at 25 November 2013, the Nambour General Hospital has over 350 casual staff, including nursing, operational and administrative staff. All casual staff members are able to apply for permanent positions as they become available, and subject to the individual casual staff member determining they would like to apply.
