QUESTION ON NOTICE No. 174 Asked on 18 March 2014

MR KNUTH asked the Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (MR McVEIGH)-

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise locations where the Mitchell and Barron Rivers have intertwined or met in a natural watercourse, wetland or flood that would allow crayfish species to migrate naturally between these systems?

ANSWER:

The Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry does not routinely seek information of that nature. However, I am not aware that the Mitchell and Barron Rivers ever intersect in such a way that would allow crayfish species to migrate naturally between the systems.
