Mrs Cunningham asked the Minister for Education, Training and Employment (MR LANGBROEK) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the significant increase in student numbers at Calliope State School—

(1) What timeline is set for an appropriate and accessible administration building to be constructed?

(2) Will the building incorporate appropriate privacy for the work of the guidance officer?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for her question.

I have been advised by my Department that:

The 2014-15 Capital Works Program is currently being formulated and the provision of an administration building at Calliope State School will be considered under this formulation process. It should be noted that the majority of funding under the Capital Works Program is directed to growth projects for classrooms to meet increasing student enrolments.

The guidance officer for Calliope State School is currently accommodated in a private office within the resources building. The management of areas within the school are the responsibility of the Principal.
