QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide general performance statistics in relation to Redcliffe and Caboolture Hospitals?

ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Kallangur for his question.

The Metro North Hospital and Health Service is the largest health service in Queensland and provides the full range of health services including rural, regional and tertiary teaching hospitals. Redcliffe and Caboolture hospitals play an integral role in the delivery of high quality health services to their respective communities.

For your information, the attachment details general performance statistics for Redcliffe and Caboolture hospitals in relation to National Elective Surgery Target (NEST) and National Emergency Access Target (NEAT) measures as part of the National Partnership Agreement (NPA).

As the Member would be aware, the Government holds Hospital and Health Services accountable for their performance and a critical component of this accountability is the publication of detailed, up-to-date and regular information on the activity and performance of Queensland Health's reporting hospitals, including Redcliffe and Caboolture hospitals. This information is publicly available on the Queensland Health website and includes such information as follows:

- Emergency Department performance;
- elective surgery performance;
- hospital activity including patient admissions, same day admissions, overnight admissions, emergency admissions, outpatient services and babies born;
- specialist outpatient data;
- healthcare infections data; and
- patient experience survey results.
