MR RICKUSS asked the Premier (MR NEWMAN)—

Will the Premier advise how the implementation of the Queensland Flood Commission final report recommendations are proceeding?

ANSWER:

Progress on implementation of the Queensland Flood Commission of Inquiry (the Commission) final report recommendations is going well.

As at 26 May 2014, 98 of the 123 recommendations which fall within the State's responsibilities have been implemented.

Twenty-five recommendations remain ongoing and progress has been made on all outstanding recommendations. The ongoing recommendations include the Brisbane River Catchment Study and the legislative framework for the regulation of levees.

The Government remains committed to implementing the Commission's recommendations to ensure that Queensland is better prepared for future floods and we will keep working with local communities to achieve this.
