Will the Premier explain why the QCoal incident, which has outraged western landholders, where the Queensland Government is allowing one of its biggest pre-2012 election donors to divert a creek 1.2 kilometres it promised to protect without having to submit a respective Environmental Impact Study, should not be investigated by the CMC?
