**MR PUCCI** asked the Minister for Transport and Main Roads (MR EMERSON) —

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise what improvements to services and routes will occur for public transport routes between Flagstone, Greenbank and Browns Plains?

**ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for Logan for the question.

As part of the south-east Queensland Network Review, a package of service improvements was made in the Logan area that better reflects the needs of the community.

One of these services is bus route 540, which now operates on an hourly frequency between Beaudesert and Browns Plains. Passengers who terminate their journey at Browns Plains Plaza have the option of connecting to feeder services that will take them to other key destinations such as hospitals, shopping centres, train stations, universities and TAFE and Brisbane City.

I am advised the Department of Transport and Main Roads is currently working with local developers in Flagstone to plan for the future public transport needs of this growing community.
