DR ROWAN asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for Transport, Minister for Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister for Trade (HON J TRAD) —

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise whether there are any current plans for additional Go Card retail facilities in the Moggill Electorate?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Moggill for the question.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) uses a number of distribution channels to provide access to *go* card services and retail partnerships are valued as part of its distribution network.

The Moggill electorate is currently served by five (5) retailers including a 7-Eleven retail outlet. The Member's constituents also have access to *go* card services at all rail stations and Queensland Rail ticket offices, on board buses, CityCats and CityFerries, via the TransLink Contact Centre (13 12 30), online via the TransLink website, and by registering for the convenience of auto-top-up using a debit or credit card.

There are no current plans to increase the number of *go* card retail facilities in the Moggill electorate area.
