QUESTION:

With reference to the former LNP Government's fully funded and costed allocation of \$35,000 made to install flashing school lights at Yeronga State School in the Yeerongpilly Electorate (funding not contingent on the Strong Choices program).

Will this allocation proceed under the Labor Government?
