MR BENNETT asked the Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries and Minister for Sport and Racing (HON W BYRNE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister outline to the House a breakdown of staffing levels of the Department of National Parks, Sport and Racing as at the change of government, by both MOHRI headcount and MOHRI FTE by the following service areas (a) Office of the Director-General (including Renewal, Finance, Internal Audit, Cabinet and Parliamentary Services, Executive Services and any staff assisting with services provided to DAF, EHP and NRM), (b) Sport and Recreation Services, (c) Office of Racing, (d) Racing Queensland, and (e) Stadiums Queensland?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the Question.

(a), (b) and (c)

The Member should be aware that on behalf of the Queensland Government, the Public Service Commission (PSC) is responsible for the collection and maintenance of public service workforce information.

As outlined in detail in the response to Question on Notice No. 131-2012, this information is collected each quarter by the PSC from across public service agencies and is then published on its website in a quarterly document titled *Queensland Public Service Workforce Profile*. This publicly accessible document is readily available to the Member and other interested persons on the PSC's website each quarter, together with other public service workforce statistics that are published annually by the PSC.

Further quarterly updates will be published on a regular basis.

(d) and (e)

Racing Queensland and Stadiums Queensland, as statutory authorities, are not included in the Public Service Commission's collection of public service workforce data. Statutory authorities are not obliged to use MOHRI. FTE information for these authorities is available in their annual reports which are also publicly available on their respective websites.
