**QUESTION:**

With reference to the former LNP Government's fully funded and costed allocation of \$35,000 made to install flashing school lights at Geebung State School in the Nudgee Electorate (funding not contingent on the Strong Choices program)—

Will this allocation proceed under the Labor Government?
