MR RYAN asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for Transport, Minister for Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister for Trade (HON J TRAD) —

QUESTION:

With reference to the ongoing need for maintenance of the lifts at the Caboolture Train Station, and the continued disruption caused to commuters—

Will the Minister outline what maintenance these lifts have received over the past three years and advise of any plans of Queensland Rail to improve the current situation?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Morayfield for the question.

Queensland Rail acknowledges that there have been some performance issues with the lifts at Caboolture station.

Lift 1 was upgraded four years ago to improve the lift operation during hot weather. Similar upgrades for lifts 2 and 3 are currently underway. The cost of these works is around \$30 000. The upgrade was completed late June 2015. The completion of these works should result in improved reliability of lifts 2 and 3.
