**MR SEENEY** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR TOURISM, MAJOR EVENTS, SMALL BUSINESS AND THE COMMONWEALTH GAMES (HON K JONES) –

QUESTION:

Will the Minister detail as at 30 June 2015 all capital works projects in the Central Queensland Region administered by the Education portfolio's departments, agencies and associated entities, that were identified as being either (a) overdue, and/or (b) over budget, including a brief description as to why either (a) or (b) applies?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for his question.

In the Central Queensland Region, the former LNP Government failed to deliver the Indoor Sports Facility at Mirani State High School listed in the department's Capital Works Program in the 2014-15 Budget Paper.

The project was originally due for completion for the start of school 2015, however was never delivered during the LNP's term of government.

I am pleased to advise the project is currently under construction with completion forecast for March 2016.

The department advise that no capital projects listed in the department's Capital Works Program in the 2014-15 Budget Paper 3 were over budget in the Central Queensland Region.
