MR DE BRENNI asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for Transport, Minister for Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister for Trade (MS TRAD) –

QUESTION:

Will the Minister inform the House of any representations made by the former member for Springwood Mr John Grant to the state planning department in regards to community concerns about the Loganholme Local Neighbourhood Plan?

ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Springwood for his question.

I can advise the House that the former Member for Springwood, Mr John Grant, made representations to the then Planning Minister in October 2014, with regard to community feedback about the Loganholme Neighbourhood Plan and development applications being lodged in Loganholme.

I have been advised that the then Planning Minister responded to the former member for Springwood on 10 December 2014, stating he was still considering Logan City Council's Loganholme Local Plan Amendment, which seeks to include the Loganholme Neighbourhood Plan into the Logan Planning Scheme. The then Planning Minister also informed the former member that public consultation would occur on the Loganholme Local Plan Amendment.

The then Planning Minister also provided advice that under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*, councils can give weight to draft planning instruments in assessing development applications, based on the maturity of the instrument and its stage in the statutory approval process.
