 ${\bf MR}$ HART ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR TOURISM, MAJOR EVENTS, SMALL BUSINESS AND THE COMMONWEALTH GAMES (HON Ms JONES) —

QUESTION:

Will the Minister detail as at 30 June 2015 all capital works projects in the North Coast Region administered by the Education portfolio's departments, agencies and associated entities which were identified as being (a) overdue, and/or (b) over budget, including a brief description as to why either (a) or (b) applies?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for his question.

I have been advised by the Department of Education and Training that the only capital works project overdue in the North Coast Region is the Peregian Springs State School project for additional classrooms, delivered under South East Queensland Schools Public Private Partnership.

I have been advised by the Department that additional classrooms for the Peregian Springs State School delivered through the LNP's PPP model were originally due for completion during 2014-15.

I can advise that the Peregian Springs State School project is currently under construction with completion forecasted for March 2016.

The Department has advised that there were no capital projects that are over budget.
