MR SEENEY asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON C R DICK) –

With reference to the Minister's answer to Question on Notice No. 110—

Will the Minister detail the total average FTE 'non-government employees' providing clinical care across Queensland Health for the 2015-16 financial year?

ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Callide for his question.

I am advised that for the period 1 July 2015 to 30 June 2016, there was a total of 844.88 average full-time equivalent (FTE) "non-government employees" providing clinical care across Queensland Health.

Non-government employees have been defined as those employees who are paid through a third party invoice (e.g. locums, nursing agency). The figure of 844.88 FTE comprises 316.36 FTE medical staff (including VMOs), 498.94 FTE nursing staff, and 29.58 FTE professional and technical staff.
