MR ROBINSON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR ENVIRONMENT AND HERITAGE PROTECTION AND MINISTER FOR NATIONAL PARKS AND THE GREAT BARRIER REEF (HON DR S MILES)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the total number of rangers employed in the management and maintenance of national parks in Queensland, including the number of Indigenous rangers as at 30 June 2016?

ANSWER:

In relation to the National Parks section of my portfolio, I can advise that the number of Active/Paid rangers by head count employed by the Department of National Parks, Sport and Racing in the management and maintenance of national parks in Queensland as at 30 June 2016 was 762. Of this total the number of Active/Paid Indigenous rangers by head count was 52.
