DR ROBINSON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR TOURISM AND MAJOR EVENTS (HON K JONES) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the recent review of RI in schools following on from a single complaint—
Will the Minister (a) finally agree to a review of the safe schools curriculum, which thousands of parents have expressed concern about and (b) finally agree to release the secret list of schools that are using the safe schools program in Queensland in line with parents' requests?

ANSWER:

- a) The Safe Schools Coalition Australia (SSCA) program is an Australian Government funded initiative. The program has been reviewed by the Federal Government as it is a federally-funded program.
- b) There is no secret list. If any parent has questions or concerns about this federally-funded program, they can contact the principal at their child's school.
