QUESTION:

With reference to page 31 of the Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program (QTRIP) (2015-16 to 2018-19) and the \$400,000 project planning study for Mt Gravatt-Capalaba Road listed to have occurred in the 2015-16 financial year—

Will the Minister confirm that the planning study has been finalised, and when outcomes from the study will be made available to local residents, in light of the \$500,000 commitment in the 2016-17 to 2019-20 QTRIP to develop a business case for an intersection upgrade?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Mansfield for the Question.

The investigation of various options to upgrade the intersection of Logan Road and Kessels Road is complete. The Department of Transport and Main Roads is reviewing the options, including their implications and benefits, before preparing to start a Business Case.

The Business Case will further develop the best options for upgrading the intersection. Before a Business Case is completed, affected land owners and the broader community will be engaged to ensure timely public involvement in the development of the preferred option.
