 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{DR}}$ ROBINSON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS (HON M DE BRENNI) —

With reference to the recent announcement of \$100M government-led housing construction currently underway or set to commence—

Will the Minister advise (a) how the \$5.6M committed to Redland City will be allocated (i) by electorate (Cleveland, Capalaba and Redlands) and, (ii) by housing type and (b) how many people these developments will accommodate (by electorate)?

ANSWER

The recent announcement on 30 August 2016 related to the total budget of projects under contract at the time, and included an approximate amount for the Redlands of \$5.6M.

In the Redlands Local Government Area, that announcement related to two projects as outlined in the table below.
