QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the patronage data from bus routes that fall within the Broadwater Electorate, broken down by route and further broken down by peak and non-peak times on weekdays and weekends, reported from the period 1 September 2015 to 31 August 2016?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Broadwater for the question.

The following information provides patronage data (boardings) from bus routes that fall within the Broadwater Electorate.

- Weekday peak is defined as any travel taken between 3am until 8:30am and 3:30pm until 7pm.
- Weekday off-peak is defined as any travel taken between 8:30am until 3:30pm and 7pm until 3am the following day.
- Public holidays during the period 1 September 2015 to 31 August 2016 have been treated as a normal week day, with patronage split between peak and off-peak.
- Weekend Off-Peak is defined as any travel taken all day on the weekend.
- Routes starting with digit 3 are School bus services and do not operate on weekends.
