MR JANETZKI ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS, MINISTER FOR RACING AND MINISTER FOR MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS (HON G GRACE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise how many redundancies (voluntary and involuntary) have been undertaken in the Department of Employment and Industrial Relations from 1 January 2016 to date?

ANSWER:

The portfolios of employment and industrial relations fall within Queensland Treasury.

In relation to those parts of Queensland Treasury, I advise the Member that the Office of Industrial Relations has received and accepted expressions of interest for a voluntary redundancy from nine (9) staff from 1 January 2016 to date. There have been no redundancies undertaken for the employment portfolio from 1 January 2016 to date.
