**MR R KATTER** asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for Transport and Minister for Infrastructure and Planning (HON J TRAD) —

**QUESTION:**

Will the Deputy Premier advise by how much (a) the revenue from the Queensland Rail owned Mount Isa rail line has increased over the past five years and (b) the annual freight haulage has increased over the same period?

**ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for Mount Isa for the question.

From the 2011-12 financial year to the 2015-16 financial year, revenue on the Mount Isa line increased by 6 per cent, in real terms. However, gross tonne kilometres decreased by 14 per cent over the same period. In some instances, the contracted path is not fully utilised by third party operators.
