MR S KNUTH ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS, MINISTER FOR RACING AND MINISTER FOR MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS (HON G GRACE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide details on what training and succession planning is available for stewards in the racing Industry?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Racing Integrity Commission (QRIC) provides the following training for race day stewards:

- Certificate IV Investigation Compliance & Enforcement Training;
- First Aid training;
- Authorised Officer training;
- Ethics Training;
- Queensland Public Service Code of Conduct;
- Media and Communication training; and
- Animal Handling techniques.

The QRIC provides succession planning for stewards through the QRIC Workforce Development Strategy, providing the opportunity to perform higher duties and relieving at level, temporary engagements and a Cadet Progression Scheme.
