**MR MILLAR** asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for Transport and Minister for Infrastructure and Planning (HON J TRAD) –

### QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier provide a list of all government land that has been identified for potential sale or development opportunity to date as part of the *Advancing our cities and regions* strategy?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Gregory for the question.

The responsibility for delivering the *Advancing our cities and regions* strategy is shared between Economic Development Queensland (EDQ) within the Department of Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning, and Property Queensland (PQ) within the Department of State Development:

- PQ is responsible for identifying surplus and under-utilised land
- EDQ collaborates with other agencies, councils, communities, and industry to identify and deliver economic and community development precincts for certain surplus sites.

The Government Land Register is reviewed regularly to identify suitable properties that are underutilised or surplus to requirements.

Clearly, not every property noted on the register would be considered, but properties currently being actively considered for renewal are the former QUT campus at Carseldine, the former Oxley Secondary College and the former Yeppoon railway precinct.

EDQ and PQ will be working to identify and deliver projects and initiatives that meet the intent of the strategy for the economic growth and community benefit of Queensland.
