# QUESTION:

With reference to the Department of Transport and Main Roads' planned business case for the intersection of Logan and Kessels/Mt Gravatt-Capalaba Road—

Will the Minister advise whether public consultation will take place, and if so in what form, and when?

# ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Mansfield for the question.

The Palaszczuk Government committed \$500,000 to investigate improvements to one of Brisbane's most congested intersections at Logan, Kessels and Mt Gravatt-Capalaba roads.

The business case is looking at improved traffic flows, public transport links, freight connectivity, and access for the local community.

Community engagement will be undertaken with affected land owners as per my department's usual practice for any proposed upgrades, and will include doorknocking, letterboxing, and information stands in the local area.
