MR CRANDON asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON C R DICK) –

Will the Minister advise how much funding Queensland Health (including HHSs) provided in 2015-16 and 2016-17 to date to non-government and private groups to deliver drug rehabilitation services (reported by year and region)?

ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Coomera for his question.

Queensland Health provides funding to non-government and private groups for the delivery of alcohol and other drug treatment services across Queensland. These services include community-based counselling, withdrawal management, residential rehabilitation and specialist services for people involved in the criminal justice system.
