MR M BOOTHMAN ASKED THE MINISTER FOR POLICE, FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to my Question on Notice asked on 29 November 2016, concerning the relocation of the Coomera Valley Rural Fire Brigade from their current facility and the prudence of housing both the Coomera Valley Rural Fire Brigade and a future State Emergency Service unit together allowing for joint training and mutually beneficial support units—

Will the Minister advise when the department will allocate the necessary funding to begin design works on this new facility supporting the safety of residents in the Northern Gold Coast?

ANSWER:

I am advised that Queensland Fire and Emergency Services and the Public Safety Business Agency are continuing to investigate all options and that, through this consultation, their aim is to achieve the best possible outcome for the Coomera Valley Rural Fire Brigade and the local community.
