With reference to the release of the Gympie Hospital masterplan in February 2016, which included a commitment to deliver an onsite CT scanner at the Gympie Hospital in early 2017, and given the government delayed the release of the plan by 12 months and the subsequent advice that the installation of the CT scanner was reliant on building modifications—

Will the Minister advise if the building modifications have been completed and when will Gympie have its much needed CT scanner?
