**MR A POWELL** ASKED DEPUTY PREMIER, MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MINISTER FOR INFRASTRUCTURE AND PLANNING (HON J TRAD) —

### QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier outline the projects (including costs and descriptions) that have been funded this financial year through the Station Upgrade program?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Glass House for the question.

As part of the Station Accessibility Upgrade Program, works at the following stations were funded during the 2016–17 financial year:

Project	2016-2017 Financial Year Costs	Description of work
Graceville and Dinmore station upgrades	\$20,988,645	Major construction works including platform raising and the installation of lifts, additional shelters, as well as a new footbridge at Dinmore station.
Alderley and Newmarket station upgrades	\$18,488,316	Major construction works including platform raising and the installation of new footbridges, lifts and additional shelters.
Nambour station upgrade	\$8,544,127	Major construction works including platform raising and the installation of a lift to the subway and additional shelter.
Strathpine and Boondall and Morayfield station upgrades	\$1,001,039	Design works underway for proposed works that include platform raising, new footbridges with lifts, and additional shelters.
Auchenflower station upgrade	\$81,443	Concept planning works that include geotechnical investigations, survey and feasibility study to develop suitable station upgrade options.
Station accessibility upgrade concept planning (future station upgrades)	\$509,058	Concept planning works that include geotechnical investigations, survey and feasibility studies to identify suitable station upgrade options.
