QUESTION:

With reference to the 11 train stations that have been announced to be receiving accessibility upgrades—

Will the Minister advise (a) the expected completion date for each station and (b) the expected costs of upgrading each station?

ANSWER:

I refer the Member to Queensland Rail's website, which features project updates for each of the stations to be upgraded as part of the Palaszczuk Government's rolling Station Accessibility Upgrade Program.
