MR J LISTER ASKED MINISTER FOR EMPLOYMENT AND SMALL BUSINESS AND MINISTER FOR TRAINING AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT (HON S FENTIMAN) —

QUESTION: With reference to TAFE Queensland—

Will the Minister provide, by financial year, the total amount TAFE Queensland has spent on corporate partnerships over the past three years?

ANSWER:

TAFE Queensland enters into a wide range of agreements with entities as part of the provision of vocational education and training, higher education and broader educational services. However, these agreements are not “corporate partnerships”.

Some examples of these arrangements include funding agreements with Commonwealth, State and Territory governments and universities. For example, TAFE Queensland in partnership with the Queensland Department of Education, supported over 157 young people as part of the What’s Next Out of Home Care fund.

Other arrangements are also made with key industry bodies such as Construction Skills Queensland or the recent partnership with Le Cordon Bleu to establish the Le Cordon Bleu Brisbane Institute at Southbank TAFE to provide students with world class culinary training.

Many arrangements are long-standing like the ten-year partnership with Ramsay Health Care. This partnership between TAFE Queensland and Ramsay Health Care’s Greenslopes Private Hospital has produced more than 600 qualified nursing staff.
