MR D JANETZKI ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide an update in relation to the department's excising of a portion of Glenvale State School's eastern boundary and the associated progress of the construction of a car park thereon?

ANSWER:

The Department of Education continues to work in partnership with the Toowoomba Regional Council (the Council), the Department of Transport and Main Roads (DTMR), parents and the school community to ensure there is a coordinated approach to road safety around state schools in the Toowoomba region.

In relation to Glenvale State School, the Council has provided initial concept designs for car parking options on the school's eastern boundary and the department has offered to excise a portion of land from the school site to support a positive outcome for the community. While the project remains the responsibility of the Council and DTMR, the school and department will continue to support this project where possible.

Departmental officers will continue to work with the Council, DTMR and Translink, through the School Traffic Working Group, to support the safety of students at Glenvale State School.
