MR A POWELL ASKED THE MINISTER FOR STATE DEVELOPMENT, MANUFACTURING, INFRASTRUCTURE AND PLANNING (HON C DICK)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the government's delivery of regional plans—

Will the Minister advise (a) when the North Queensland Regional Plan will be finalised and (b) whether the government is planning to review or prepare any other regional plans?

ANSWER:

- (a) It is anticipated that the draft North Queensland Regional Plan will be released for statutory public consultation after consideration by the Queensland Government. Public consultation will run for a minimum of 60 business days. Release of the finalised plan is expected in mid-2019.
- (b) The government is committed to ensuring statutory regional plans for all regions across Queensland are prepared and regularly reviewed to ensure they remain contemporary in addressing state and regional issues and supporting prosperous communities.
