MR B MICKELBERG ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to crime prevention—

Will the Minister advise what State Government support is available to local councils, financial or otherwise, to improve lighting in dimly lit pedestrian corridors in order to improve safety?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Police Service (QPS) considers environmental design, including lighting, to be an important element of crime prevention, however I am advised by the QPS that it is primarily the responsibility of local council.

The Honourable Stirling Hinchliffe MP, Minister for Local Government, Minister for Racing and Minister for Multicultural Affairs, is better placed to answer the question.
