**MRS S WILSON** ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

### QUESTION:

With reference to the Federal announcement of \$20m for Bribie Island Road upgrades, some 8 weeks ago—

Will the Minister advise (a) the priority areas for the spending of this funding and (b) the progress of official discussions between the State and Federal Governments on this funding?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Pumicestone for the question.

The Palaszczuk Government is still waiting for confirmation of the \$20 million the Turnbull Government announced for upgrades to Bribie Island Road. As such, the funding has not yet been allocated to specific projects.

More than \$20 million has already been allocated to Caboolture–Bribie Island Road by the Palaszczuk Government, including:

- an upgrade of Caboolture–Bribie Island Road intersection with Old Toorbul Point Road – \$10.4 million
- safety improvements at the Lee and Peel Roads intersection and Aylward Road intersection at Ningi – \$3.7 million
- detailed planning and design to improve motorist and pedestrian safety on Caboolture–Bribie Island Road between Kal Ma Kuta Drive and Bestmann Road (East) intersections – \$755,000
- installation of a dedicated right-turn lane on Caboolture–Bribie Island Road – \$797,000
- planning for an upgrade of the two-lane section of Caboolture–Bribie Island Road to a four-lane, median-divided carriageway between Hickey and Saint Roads intersections – \$2 million
- resurfacing works undertaken on both carriageways of Caboolture–Bribie Island Road, west of the Lee and Peel Roads intersection – \$1.5 million.
